Description  (min. 100 words, include objective, outcome, etc.)	Prof. Richardson Lawrence in his session on Soft Skills highlighted the importance of developing soft skills such as communication, teamwork, leadership and problem -solving. Reinforcing how these skills are linked to how one works and interacts with others, he also pointed out that these skills are essential for success and career growth. Prof Lawrence demonstrated with examples how skills like adaptability, decision-making, leadership, team work, creativity, flexibility, listening, negotiation, networking, people skills, public speaking, time management and organising skills go a long way in shaping one's career and professional growth. He emphasized how soft skills represent one's approach to life and work, and how inculcating these are the need of the hour.  As most organizations emphasize soft skills, Prof Richardson motivated students to participate in activities and programmes that would enhance their emotional intelligence and work ethic. He also conducted a team activity to highlight how soft skills can be properly channelised.
