Road to safety







Feel the Jail

You do not want to go to jail, right!!! But in case you have always wondered what it is to live in a jail, the old district jail at Sangareddy in Telangana's Medak district has been opened for you to experience 'prison life' for a fee. The Sangareddy District Central Jail in Medak district, 70 kms from Hyderabad, which was built by the Nizams in 1796 has been converted into a museum in June this year. Under Telangana Prison department 's new program of 'Feel the jail', a citizen can rent a cell in the Heritage jail and Museum. Mr. Vinay kumar Singh, DG of Prisons Dept and Correctional Services said, 'The tourist can stay in the cell. He would be served the same food given to inmates of the prison and has to follow the schedule of prisoners. Feel of real prison life would dissuade people from indulging in wrong things'. This innovative program provides a behind-bars experience as real possible, while a shorter tour of the jail museum is also on offer. This offer is the first in the country.
