Library and information centre at Aurora's Technological and Research Institute is an academic library, whose prime objective is to meet the academic needs of the engineering students for which it is created.

Our computerized library has a collection of 33800 books, 5350 titles, 2000 CD-ROMs and 110 periodicals.
